## Metro Catholic Outreach

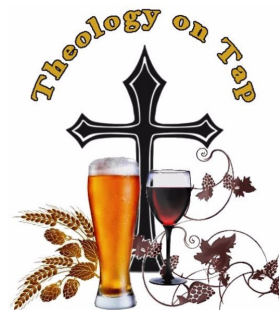
