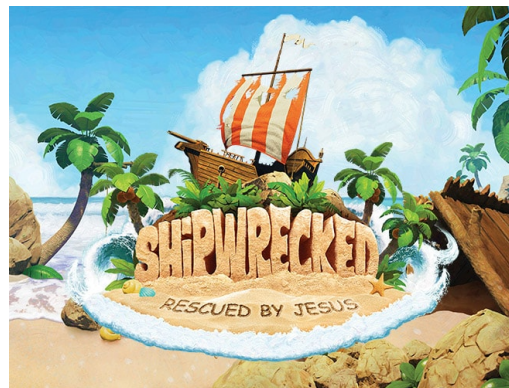

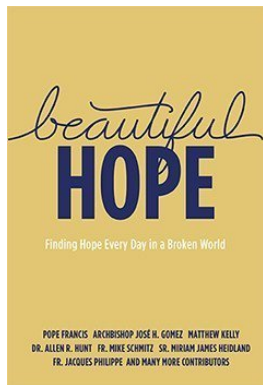
St. Elizabeth Ann Seton has partnered with HACAP, Hy-Vee and MCO to provide food to those in need
